MEMO - Japan Disaster: Information on possible impact on deliveries

Dear Partners,

We have been proactive and have installed an internal company task force on Monday (14th March 2011) to investigate this matter further. So far we have only found a limited range of electronic components which are made in Japan and which may be affected. However indirect effects due to damaged infrastructure etc. are not clear at this stage.

We are actively contacting the distributors of these components to find out if there will be sourcing issues. However currently many companies are requesting this information from these distributors so they are having their own capacity problems in terms of supplying detailed information.

As this disaster is not under our control and nobody can really say how the nuclear power plant situation will transpire, we can not give a 100% clear answer at this stage. However we can assure you that we monitor and investigate this situation carefully.

Our thoughts and prayers go out to the Japanese people in this difficult time.
